



To Parents:

The process for selecting the members of the National Honor Society of DHS is underway. If your 10<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grader received a letter stating that he/she met the scholarship criteria, then he or she is eligible to pursue a nomination. For an application to be considered, candidates must:

- Complete the included application, including a typed essay.
  - Please note that an email address *must* accompany the sponsor information where requested.
  - Please include all service and leadership activities that would enhance the application.
- Ask two teachers to complete a confidential evaluation.
  - The student must provide each teacher adequate time to complete the evaluation.
  - The evaluation will remain confidential.
  - The teachers will return these evaluations to Mr. Carreon.
- **Turn in all requested materials by Wednesday, April 7, 2010 at 8:00am.**
  - *Complete applications must be turned into Dawn Moisey at the high school reception area.*
  - *Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.*

The NHS Faculty Council will then review all complete applications. Brian Carreon and Courtney Carreon are serving as the chapter's nonvoting NHS Faculty Advisers. The formal NHS selection process is listed below.

1. Only those 10<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade students who have attended Dhahran High School for one semester or more are eligible to be considered for membership.
2. All 10<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade students who have been attending DHS at least one semester and have a cumulative *\*non-weighted GPA* of 3.4 or above are eligible and have been notified by an eligibility letter.
3. Eligible students were informed that they must complete an application in order to be considered further. The application documents each student's accomplishments in service, leadership, and extracurricular activities. The packet also includes two faculty evaluations.
4. The NHS Faculty Council will meet to review all completed applications. The leadership, service, and character of all candidates will be carefully assessed.
5. Candidates receiving a majority vote by the Faculty Council will be selected for induction into the chapter.
6. Candidates and their parents will be given a formal notification of their selection in writing as well as an invitation and information about the induction ceremony.
7. Candidates who are not selected will also be notified in writing.
8. Candidates will be asked to verify their acceptance of membership in the chapter record and to plan to attend the induction ceremony.

*\*note that the non-weighted GPA was specifically calculated for NHS eligibility, and is not reflected on the student's transcript or report card.*
