Dear Colleagues,

On behalf of the Dhahran High School Model United Nations Club, I am pleased to invite your school to our third annual **Dhahran Model United Nations (DHAMUN) Conference** to be held here on the DHS campus on March 9th and 10th, 2011. Please note that we have scheduled the conference at a different time than last year; we hope this will avoid conflicts with the SAIKAC MUN as well as any tournaments.

Our goal is to develop the strengths established at previous years' conferences. We will continue with our original vision for DHAMUN as a local forum where younger, inexperienced students can be introduced to the Model United Nations program in a low-risk environment. For this reason we are limiting participation to students in 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade. Students in 11<sup>th</sup> grade may also be considered for chair positions.

At the DHAMUN Conference, most students will represent a different delegation within our General Assembly which will be divided into sub-committees. In addition, other students will sit on a 15-nation Security Council and a 15-nation Arab League. We are committed to equitably distributing these positions between our visiting schools.

At this point we only want a commitment to attend and an approximate number of delegates that you anticipate sending.
